The goal of TRADE (Technology Related Accommodation Development and Empowerment) is to equip adults with disabilities to be competent in using computers with the support of assistive technology. The TRADE program includes two tracks. One is for adults who wish to increase their employability as they learn touch-typing, Internet use, and the basics of Microsoft Office applications. The other is geared toward students who wish to work at their own pace to develop skills in using the Internet and Microsoft Office applications.
